



2012 Presentation Themes

Speakers

The East Solar Conference 2012 will feature a line-up of expert solar speakers who will chart the rise of solar and its market prospects out to 2020. Best of all it will be a free event, to educate people on the significant contribution solar is already making.

Some of the highlight plenary speakers from Solar 2011 included:

Clover Moore MP, Lord Mayor of Sydney, and **Allan Jones MBE** delivered opening keynote presentations on the City of Sydney's 2030 Sustainable Vision and Allan's success achieving energy savings in the City of London, and other UK centres.

Jeff Lyng, President of the American Solar Energy Society, spoke of the successful implementation of the Colorado Renewable Energy Portfolio Standards which yielded 30% savings.

Mal Thorp represented the *Department of Climate Change and Energy Efficiency* to provide an update on the highly successful Solar Cities Programme.

Wu Dacheng, Secretary-General, Solar PV Committee of China Renewable Energy Society (CRES), spoke of current developments in solar research and implementation in China

Professor Martin Green, University of NSW delivered *Photovoltaics: Recent Developments and Australia's Role as Asia/Pacific Technology and Training Hub.* Prof Green received an AuSES Award recognising his lifelong contribution to PV research.

The Chief Climate Commissioner, Professor Tim Flannery was represented by **Gerry Hueston**, who outlined the initiatives in place to enable Australia to achieve its climate change agenda.

Dr Christian Holter and **Dr Milou Beerepoort of the International Energy Agency Solar Heating and Cooling Group**, spoke about the Agency's views on solar energy, and ran an internationally focused workshop on the SHC 'Roadmap'.

Mark Twidell gave an update on the *Australian Solar Institute*, of which he is Executive Director.

Dr Dave Renne, President, International Solar Energy Society, provided significant insights into solar radiation monitoring and reporting carried out by the US National Renewable Energy Laboratory.

Ned Harvey delivered a video presentation on the work of **Amory Lovins' Rocky Mountain Institute**, a leading energy efficiency and renewables adoption advocacy organisation. Ned focussed on the lessons apparent in the RMI's recently published, research report 'Reinventing Fire'.

The Bloomberg New Energy Finance view of emerging renewables finance potential was presented by its *Australian Director, Kobad Bhavnagri*.

Presentations were also delivered in person or on video, by key members of the three major Federal political parties; *The Hon Greg Combet MP, Minister for Climate Change and Energy Efficiency, Senator Christine Milne and the Hon Greg Hunt MP.*









Option A: Raw Space only

All construction, decoration and furniture hire is to be paid for by the Exhibitor.

The hire cost of forklift services for the move in and move out is to be booked with *Agility* and this contract is to be paid directly to that company.

STAND FLOORING

As per the MCEC Exhibition Stand Guidelines:

A stand may have up to a 32mm high lip without bevelling

Between 32mm and 115mm, bevelling of the edge must occur.

This bevelling must not exceed an angle of 30 degrees or a grading of 1:1.4.

Bevelling is also to be incorporated within the stand space and must not encroach out into the aisle way.

All flooring that is over 115mm is classed as a step and if the public requires access, a wheelchair ramp needs to be installed, with a 1 metre high hand rail.

MCEC requires that stands are open for visual inspection at all times.

No stands are to be enclosed by any fabric or material at any time.

LIGHTING

All lighting must be 2.2 meters above floor level. Any variation must be approved.

High-powered lights such as floods or spots must not be placed within 500mm of flammable material.

All portable light fittings must have a Certificate of Suitability or a Certificate of Approval from Australian or New Zealand Electrical Safety Regulators.





Option B: Shell Scheme Stands

Stand Specification

WALLS

2.5m high white melamine walls in an Aluminium Octanorm frame.

Items which can be used on walls

When attaching anything to walls, exhibitors are asked to use Velcro, bluetac, double-sided adhesive tape or wall-mounted shelving and hooks, all are available from *ExpoNet* if required.

Items which cannot be used on walls

Pins, staples, screws, nails, bolts, glue and paint will permanently damage the panels, and exhibitors are requested not to use them.

Repairs addressing any damage to panels or other supplied components may be recharged back to Exhibitors.

FASCIA

Aluminium frame with standard green fascia board, limited to 30 characters

LIGHTING

2 x 120 watt track mounted spotlights will be supplied per 9 sqm, and mounted inside the fascia frame.

POWER

1 x 4 amp power point will be supplied per stand regardless of size and located in a rear corner of the stand.

If you choose to have your fascia removed, the standard track spot light allocation will be replaced with 1 \times 300 watt on-arm light which clamps to the booth wall.

FLOORING

Flooring will be made up of 1m x 1m carpet tiles in charcoal grey.

The Exhibitor agrees and undertakes to ensure in their full replacement value the contents of their stand and all associated equipment and materials.

The Organisers may, in the event of any unforeseen circumstances which render it necessary, mend or alter the location of the stand allocated to the Exhibitor and the Exhibitor undertakes to agree to any alteration to the site or the space reallocation by the Organisers. Exhibitors are responsible for the safety of his products, display and stand. During move-out period, material should not be left unattended at any time.


